

## ***Wisconsin Virtual School Advanced Placement (AP)\* Program***

Wisconsin Virtual School (WVS) is YOUR Wisconsin Web Academy. The Wisconsin Web Academy (WWA) is a partnership between DPI and CESA 9. WVS provides online course opportunities for middle school and high school students in schools throughout Wisconsin. WVS allows districts to offer online courses that otherwise may not be available to their students.

Wisconsin Virtual School is administered from Cooperative Educational Service Agency (CESA) #9 by Director, Dawn Nordine. WVS uses Wisconsin certified teachers to offer quality online courses that meet state and national standards. WVS makes getting involved in online learning uncomplicated by establishing a partnership with local districts.

Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered online through an agreement between WVS and Aventa Learning, an AP online course provider. (For further information about Aventa Learning visit their website at [www.aventallearning.com](http://www.aventallearning.com).)

The Advanced Placement program allows students to take college level courses and earn college credit while they are still in high school, based on their score on the College Board AP Exam. More information on the College Board can be found at:

## ***Registration***

***First Semester:*** Registration begins August 23, 2010. The first day of class begins August 30, 2010. **Recommended** start dates are August 30 – September 17, 2010.

***Second Semester:*** Registration begins December 20, 2010. The first day of class begins January 3, 2011. **Recommended** start dates are January 3 – January 31, 2011.

### *College Board AP Teacher Training*

### *How to Order AP Exams*

AP Exams for testing students on AP courses are only available through the College Board, and **must be ordered by late March**. If you are a new school to the AP Exam process you will need to have a College Board code number.

- \* Call the College Board code control center at 877-274-6474 to check whether your school has an active code or to request a high school code request form.
- \* Once the code is received, orders for exams must be placed via the AP Online Exam Ordering Service, [www.collegeboard.org/school](http://www.collegeboard.org/school).
