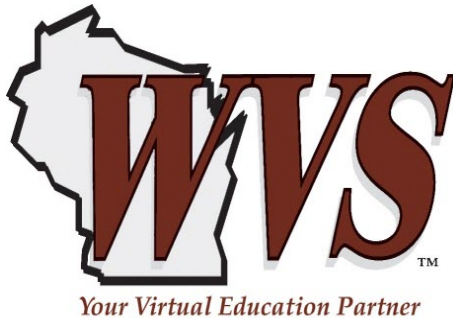


Wisconsin Virtual School, YOUR Wisconsin Web Academy, has set the following enrollment dates for the 2010-2011 school year:



**Fall Session 2010 – August 23 to December 17, 2010** – The fall session has been extended to accommodate trimester school districts.  
Fall Enrollments **begin** August 23, 2010  
Fall Enrollments **end** on December 17, 2010

**Spring Session 2011 – December 20, 2010 – May 20, 2011**  
Spring Enrollments **begin** December 20, 2010  
Spring Enrollments **end** on May 20, 2011

**Advanced Placement Enrollments** – We are now **recommending** rather than requiring windows in which the students should begin working to be successful and have an opportunity to gain as much knowledge as possible prior to the 2011 early May AP Exams.

**AP Enrollments will be allowed after the recommended dates based on your school's needs.**

Recommended Fall Enrollments **begin** August 23, 2010  
Recommended Fall Enrollments **end** September 17, 2010  
Availability of the First Day of Class August 30, 2010

Recommended Spring Enrollments **begin** December 20, 2010  
Recommended Spring Enrollments **end** January 31, 2011  
Availability of the First Day of Class January 3, 2011

**Summer Session 2011– June 13 to August 5, 2011**

This is an 8 week session ONLY. Students will NOT have 5 months access. Extensions will be available for a fee. (Extension policy:

**Tip:** If you want more than 8 weeks access for a summer student, you'll need to enroll them before the spring term closes on May 20 with a start date on or before 5/20/10. **PLEASE ensure the student will have a LEG monitoring their progress in the summer months.**

Summer Enrollments **begin** May 23, 2011 **\*\*Classes start on June 13, 2011.**  
Summer Enrollments **end** on July 8, 2011 **\*\*Courses must be completed by August 5, 2011.**
