WVS offers **no cost** support for the following critical components for planning, implementing, and evaluating your LOCAL programs:

- Assistance for districts that want to maintain enrollments locally and provide online opportunities for students and families that have left your districts for other options.
- Provide support and training of staff and local teachers that serve your online students.
- Provide a **free** online flexible professional learning resource tool for school districts that can assist schools in planning and implementing a local online or blended program. Use this **QR code** for further details.



Below are a few of the many highlights available to WVS partner schools

- **No** minimum course requirement. No contracts to sign or membership fees to pay.
- Student Centered Learning Management System, weekly progress reports emailed.
- 14 different curriculum sources including **the ability to build your own course**.
- Pricing per enrollment has remained stable or has been reduced since 2000:
 - \$295 per half credit semester enrollment for High School, Middle School, and AP;
 - \$200 per half credit semester enrollment for specific credit recovery courses used year round, for summer school, or alternative education enrollments;
 - \$325 for dual enrollment semester courses;
 - Cost effective content-only solutions if a school district uses their own teacher **\$150** per enrollment per semester course.
- **FREE** Online Student Orientation course for all students enrolled in a WVS course.
- 24/7 Tutoring Service, in addition to weekly virtual office hours with teachers and M-F Helpdesk.
- Online and blended teacher training regionally or onsite.
- Local control & decision making (use **your** local teachers, WVS teachers, **or both**).

When utilizing Wisconsin Virtual School (WVS), **districts maintain control and funding for local enrollments**, decisions, policies, and awarding of credits. WVS is available with many pathways that will enable each Wisconsin school district to build their **"own" online program/school** supported with collaborative expertise, quality curriculum, and services.
