



Wisconsin Virtual School Summer 2019

Enrollments accepted through June 30, 2019

(*Start date no later than 6-30-2019)

Wisconsin Virtual School (WVS) offers a variety of courses in the summer, including required courses like math, science, history, English and five world languages; and elective courses like Criminology, Sports and Entertainment Marketing, and Introduction to Veterinary Science. It's easy with WVS to provide **more options for more students** to make up credits or accelerate their learning paths to meet their Academic Career Plans.

The course fee (with a WVS Instructor) is \$295 for HS and MS courses, and \$200 for Credit Recovery (half-credit semester courses). A maximum of 20 weeks access is allowed for HS and MS courses. A maximum of 20 weeks access is allowed for Credit Recovery courses. Due to the rigor of Advanced Placement courses, they are not recommended for a summer session. Contact us for more information on training and utilizing your **OWN** teachers (\$150 per semester course)!

Many schools want to follow a "typical summer school schedule" and allow students a specific 6-8 week summer session for their online courses. With enrollments accepted through June 30, you can "design" the right number of weeks and dates you want for YOUR summer program. **PLEASE NOTE: Health and Physical Education courses require a minimum of 12 weeks of fitness/health journals/logs.** You have flexibility to provide students with more time to successfully complete a summer online course.

It is strongly recommended that students enroll in no more than ONE semester course during the summer. Past experience has shown that students who are given a completion deadline similar to the local summer school session are more likely to finish the online course than if they are allowed to work into the fall.

It is imperative that a Coach/Local Education Guide/Mentor be available to act as a liaison between the student and the WVS teacher during the summer.
